### **JANUARY MEETING UPDATE**

John Bartges started the meeting off by presenting a check for \$400 to SCPYWO. This represents the \$1 per child fee for registering wrestlers over the website for tournaments.

A motion was made to vote on how a wrestler won/loss record should be kept. This vote will be at the February meeting on whether the wrestlers' record should be brought forward every year or if the wrestler should start with a 0-0 record. Please plan to attend to voice your opinion on this issue.

Please make sure that you are weighing your wrestlers on a regular basis. Also make sure that the wrestlers are properly placed in their appropriate skill level. We want this to be a learning experience for all wrestlers.

The tournament schedule was brought up with a discussion concerning the Garden Spot and McCaskey tournaments. A question was asked of the board if SCPYWO can dictate tournament dates so there are no conflicts. This is an issue that SCPYWO has no control over since most programs are at the mercy of their host school for dates when they can use the gym to host a tournament. We are asking that since tournaments are a major fund raiser for most programs that when registering your wrestlers please be flexible or willing to help out a tournament that does not have a lot of wrestlers registered so that we don't have tournaments cancelled. We should be an organization that supports all of our wrestlers.
